On July 12, 2016, the Bain Capital Entities distributed 320,115 shares of Common Stock to one or more members or partners of the Bain Capital Entities, including 92,267 shares to Mr. Bekenstein in connection with certain charitable gifts made by such members or partners on July 12, 2016.
