On June 6, 2007, Command Security Corporation (the "Company") announced that its shares of common stock have been approved for listing on the American Stock Exchange (the "AMEX") and anticipates that such shares will begin trading on the AMEX on June 8, 2007 under the ticker symbol "MOC."

The AMEX Panel's approval is contingent upon the Company being in compliance with the Alternative Listing Standards at the time the Company's common shares begin trading on the AMEX, and may be rescinded if the Company is not in compliance with such standards.
