Once earned, the PSUs vest and are paid through the issuance of shares of Common Stock in four approximately equal annual installments commencing on or about May 1, 2005, 2006, 2007 and 2008, subject to the reporting person's continued employment or association with the Issuer on the date such shares of Common Stock are to be issued.

A Performance Share Unit, sometimes referred to as a Performance Stock Unit or PSU, represents the conditional right to receive one share of Common Stock. Once earned, the PSUs vest and are paid through the issuance of shares of Common Stock in three approximately equal annual installments commencing on or about May 1, 2006, 2007 and 2008, subject to the reporting person's continued employment or association with the Issuer on the date such shares of Common Stock are to be issued.

Once earned, the PSUs vest and are paid through the issuance of shares of Common Stock in four approximately equal annual installments commencing on or about May 1, 2007, 2008, 2009 and 2010, subject to the reporting person's continued employment or association with the Issuer on the date such shares of Common Stock are to be issued.

In respect of the PSUs granted in April 2004 with respect to fiscal year 2005, on May 2, 2005, the reporting person earned the right to receive 6,864 shares of Common Stock. The reporting person was associated with the issuer on May 2, 2005, resulting in the vesting and issuance of 1,716 of the 6,864 shares of Common Stock so earned. On May 4, 2006, the reporting person reporting person continued to be associated with the issuer, resulting in the vesting and issuance of another 1,716 shares of Common Stock so earned. On May 1, 2007, the reporting person reporting person continued to be associated with the issuer, resulting in the vesting and issuance of another 1,716 shares of Common Stock so earned. The remaining 1,716 shares have been earned, but are not yet vested.

In respect of the PSUs granted in April 2004 with respect to fiscal year 2006, on May 4, 2006, the reporting person earned the right to receive 726 shares of Common Stock. The reporting person was associated with the issuer on May 4, 2006, resulting in the vesting and issuance of 242 of the 726 shares of Common Stock so earned. On May 1, 2007, the reporting person continued to be associated with the issuer, resulting in the vesting and issuance of another 242 shares of Common Stock so earned. The remaining 242 shares have been earned, but are not yet vested.

The reporting person was associated with the issuer on May 1, 2007, resulting in the vesting and issuance of 1,292 of the 2,585 shares of Common Stock so earned. The remaining 1,292 shares have been earned, but are not yet vested.

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In respect of the PSUs granted in May 2005 with respect to fiscal year 2006, on May 4, 2006, the reporting person earned the right to receive 2,625 shares of Common Stock. The reporting person was associated with the issuer on May 4, 2006, resulting in the vesting and issuance of 875 of the 2,625 shares of Common Stock so earned. On May 1, 2007, the reporting person continued to be associated with the issuer, resulting in the vesting and issuance of another 875 shares of Common Stock so earned. The remaining 875 shares have been earned, but are not yet vested.
