**MONTREAL, May 31, 2006** CN announced today that it has entered into a five-year accounts receivable securitization program, of up to a maximum of C\$600 million, with RBC Capital Markets. The new program replaces CN's current receivables securitization program that was set to expire in the second quarter of 2006.
