On October 24, 2005, First Charter Corporation announced that it had executed a series of initiatives to reposition and deleverage its balance sheet. First Charter s balance sheet was deleveraged by approximately \$446 million through the sale of approximately \$466 million in fixed-rate investment securities and the extinguishment of \$446 million in debt. As a result of these initiatives, First Charter will recognize an approximate \$20 million after-tax charge in the fourth quarter of 2005.
